

## **The Door of Protection**

Exodus 11:1-12:36

1. The Passover door \_\_\_\_\_ us that every slave of sin needs God's way of salvation.
2. The Passover door \_\_\_\_\_ us that rejecting God's way of salvation always results in death. (11:1-10)
3. The Passover door \_\_\_\_\_ us that God's way of salvation required an acceptable blood sacrifice. (12:1-27)
4. The Passover door \_\_\_\_\_ us that God's way of salvation is received through obedient faith. (12:28-36)

## **Questions for Further Study and Discussion**

1. What did you find most challenging, helpful or troubling from this message?
2. Do you believe that someone must first be convicted of his/her sin before he/she can be saved? If yes, would you say it is wrong to encourage someone to receive Christ who is not convicted of his/her sin? Explain your answer.
3. How would you respond to a skeptic who says, "What God did to the Egyptians on the night of the Passover was not fair. In fact, I don't think it is fair for anyone who has never heard the Gospel to be condemned to hell"?
4. Why is simply listening to Jesus' teachings and following His example not good enough to earn someone salvation? Why must he/she believe in Christ's finished work on the cross for salvation? Please support your answer with Scripture.
5. Do you believe that praying to receive Jesus as your Savior is the same as the obedient faith of salvation? Why or why not?
